Annually, Langhorne Creek also hosts the Langhorne Creek Winemakers' Showcase Tasting in the Langhorne Creek Memorial Hall in May, and converges on the Strathalbyn Racecourse for the Langhorne Creek Vignerons' Raceday in November.
